**ENTRY FEES** are \$16.00 first entry (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee) and \$16.00 each additional entry, same dog/same day (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee).

**ONLINE ENTRIES:** You may enter via AKC's ONLINE ENTRY SERVICES. Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at [www.akc.org/AgilityEntry](http://www.akc.org/AgilityEntry) and follow the instructions there to use your My AKC account to enter this event. **During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries per day designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 83 runs/day via online entries 247 runs/day via paper entries.** If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

100% of entry fees will be refunded for any reason if a written (or email) request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date and time. After closing, refunds less fees will be given for bitches in season if written (or email) notification is received by the trial secretary prior to the start of the trial. Verification from a veterinarian may be required at the club's discretion.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Bitches in season are not allowed on the Trial grounds.

**JUDGING** will begin at 2:30 PM on Friday, 8:00 AM on Saturday and 8:00 AM on Sunday. Judge's briefing and course walk-through will take place prior to judging. See below for building opening hours/availability.

**ORDER OF CLASSES** is SUBJECT TO CHANGE based on number of entries received. The final order will be included with the confirmation and judging schedule issued after closing. Class order is expected to be:

FRI: JWW, STD, FAST (Exc level only)

SAT: FAST, STD, JWW (all levels)

SUN: JWW, STD, FAST (all levels)

*On SAT and SUN, in all classes:*

*Excellent, followed by Open, followed by Novice*

**RULES:** All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by contacting the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, by phone (919) 233-9767, by email at [info@akc.org](mailto:info@akc.org), or on their website at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org). It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered correctly, and double-check your preliminary confirmation. **If you have questions about which class to enter, please contact the Trial Secretary before the closing date.**

**OBSTACLES:** Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials (available at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org)).

### **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

**CATALOG:** \$10.00 Please pre-order catalogs by checking the box on the entry form. A very limited number will be available for purchase at the trial for \$15.00.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class. A dog toy (offered by FVCK; value \$2.00-5.00) will be awarded to first place in each height division in each class. Raffle tickets for prize baskets (one per day) will be given for all qualifying runs. A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

*All dogs earning their MACH or PAX titles at this trial will receive a MACH or PAX bar and ribbon! If you are close to earning an award, please let the trial secretary know so we are prepared to celebrate with you.*

**MOVE-UPS:** Move-ups after entries close must be submitted in writing so that the Trial Secretary receives them by **6:00 PM MDT on Monday April 12, 2010**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via postal mail, or email to [LNRose22@hotmail.com](mailto:LNRose22@hotmail.com). If you do not receive a prompt acknowledgement of your move-up request, please contact the Trial Secretary to make sure that it was received. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups for Saturday and Sunday must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last class on Friday and Saturday.

**VETERINARIAN (on call):** Emergency Animal Clinic, 1914 S Reserve St., Missoula (406) 829-9300. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**All dogs** must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **The safety of dogs is of primary concern.** By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**HEIGHT DIVISION:** The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes.

### **NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process**

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

## HEIGHT CARD FAQs

### How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?

**If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date:** One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy and check "My dog has a **Temporary** Jump Height Form" box, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

**If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date:** A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

**Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement:** If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Reqst Perm" box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

### What if my dog measures into a different jump height than what he is entered?

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

### May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement?

Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process once after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.)

### What is the jump height card challenge process?

The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge measurements are required. If both challenge measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class.

Until such time that you have received all required challenge measurements, you must continue to compete at the original jump height stated on the permanent jump height card that is in your possession.

**It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.***

## MIXED BREED CLASSES

Effective April 1, 2010 mixed breed classes may be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Clubs are not required to offer these optional classes.

Mixed breed dogs shall compete in separate (but equivalent) classes from purebreds. (Novice A Mixed Breed, Novice B Mixed Breed, etc.) All dogs competing in a jump height run at the same time, under the same judge, however placements and titles are scored and awarded separately.

All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an [AKC Canine Partners listing number](#) before they may enter an AKC Agility event. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS:** Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement attached, are not acceptable. Checks for entry fees will be deposited soon after the closing date. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee, except for bitches in season as specified on page 2. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

**CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY:** If the exhibitor provides an e-mail address, it is assumed that the exhibitor can receive e-mail with attachments from the Trial Secretary. A preliminary confirmation will be sent via email soon after your entry is received; please REVIEW IT CAREFULLY and notify the secretary of any necessary changes as soon as possible. Please make sure your spam blocker is set to accept messages from [LNRose22@hotmail.com](mailto:LNRose22@hotmail.com). A final confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent via email after the closing date. If an e-mail address is not provided, confirmation of entry will be sent by USPS after closing (no preliminary confirmations will be sent). If an exhibitor has not received a confirmation and schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

The **FIVE VALLEY KENNEL CLUB** and the **Trial Secretary** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

**Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds (and at your motel). We want to retain these facilities for future events.**

**SITE INFORMATION:** Lolo Peak Arena, 16175 Hwy 12W, Lolo, MT. The trials will be held indoors on packed dirt. On Friday, the building will open for indoor exhibitor setups starting at 12:30 PM (the club will be setting up the ring in the arena prior to the building opening for exhibitors). The arena will be open to exhibitors at 7:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday. There is ample room for crating indoors, but please take only the space you need. The Trial Committee reserves the right to consolidate or move setups if necessary, to ensure crating space is available for all and access to the ring is maintained.

**CONCESSIONS** will be available Friday evening, and Saturday and Sunday for breakfast and lunch.

**VENDORS:** Due to limited indoor crating space, vendors will be limited indoors and will be close to, but not in, the general crating area. Vending spaces must be reserved in advance, do NOT have power, and are \$10 per day per spot. **AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.
